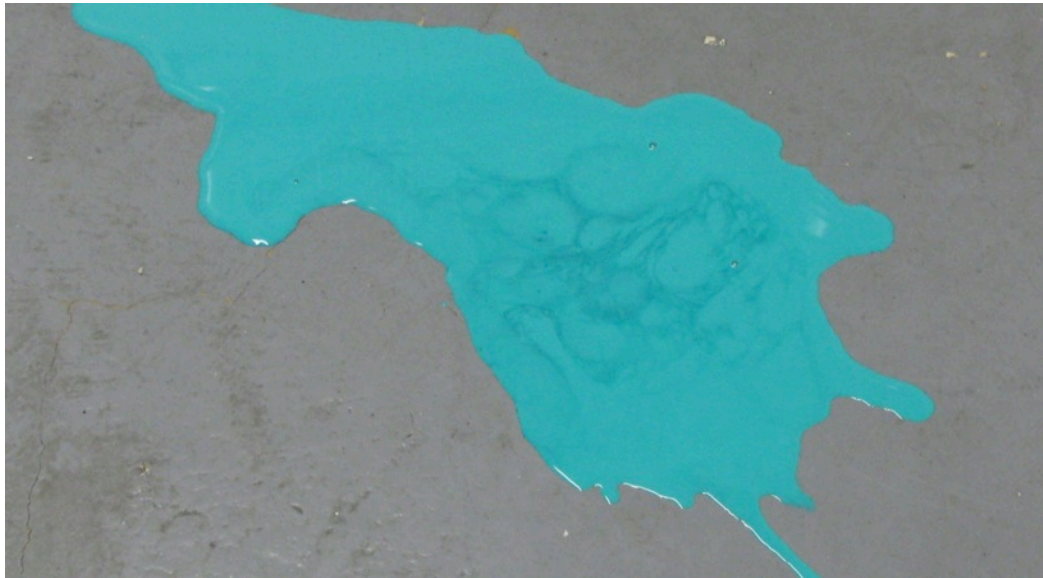

Step 1

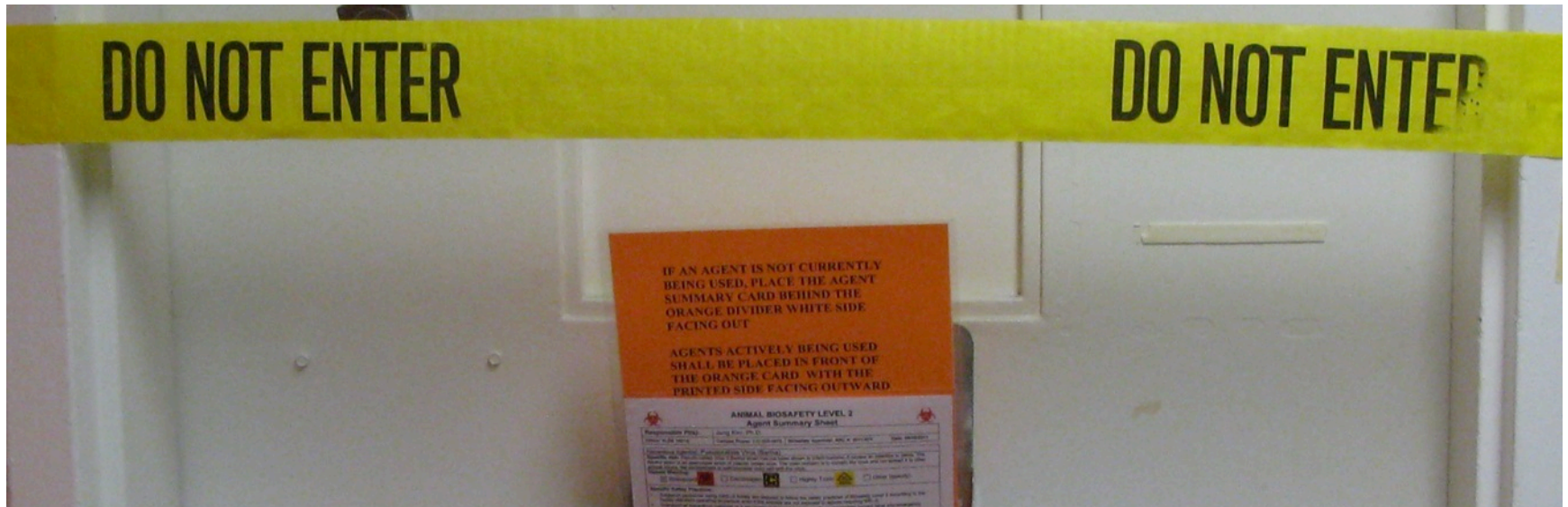


✓ **Alert others in room**

✓ Alert others outside of room

Step 3



✓ **Change PPE if contaminated**

Step 4

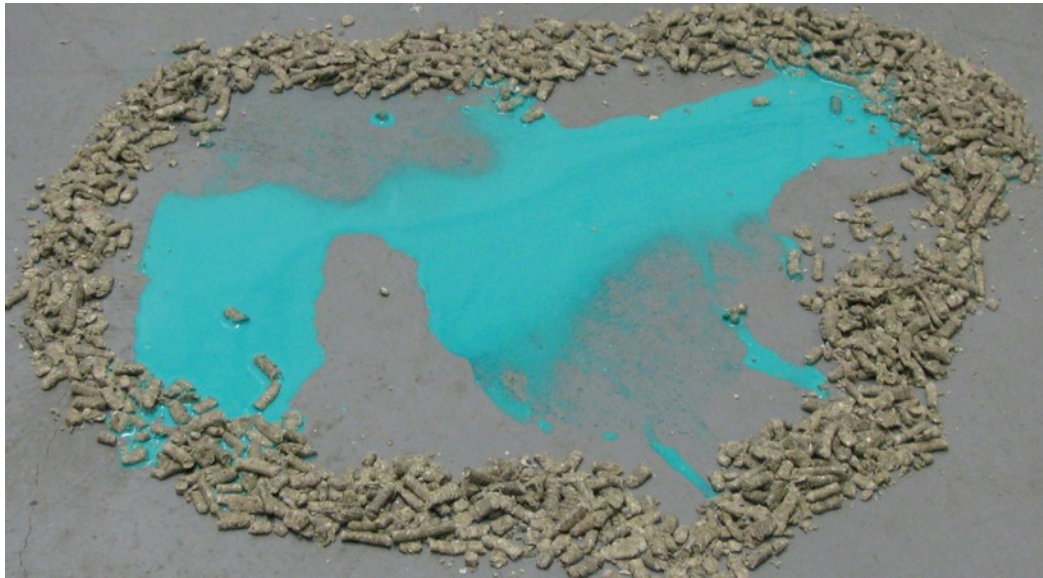


✓ Retrieve Biohazard Spill Kit

Step 5



✓ Place absorbent around the spill to contain it

Step 6

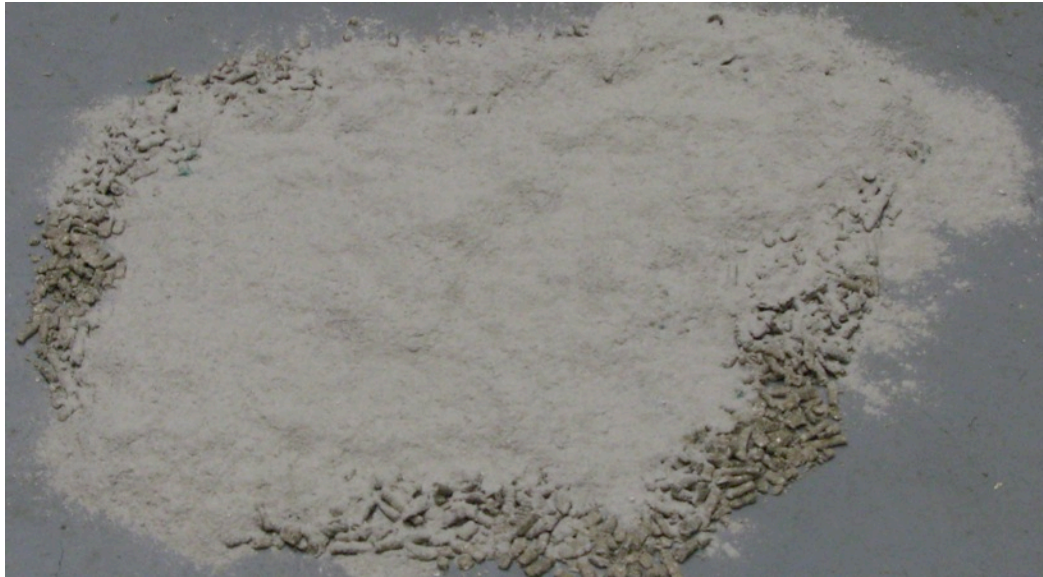


✓ **Cover spill with absorbent material (e.g. Super Sorbent)**



Biohazardous Spill Clean Up

Step 7



✓ **Cover the entire spill to soak it all up**



Biohazardous Spill Clean Up

Step 8



✓ **Make 10% bleach solution (bleach to blue line; water to black line)**



Biohazardous Spill Clean Up

Step 9



- ✓ **Pour 10% bleach solution, from the outer edge of the spill to its center**

Step 10



✓ **Allow 20 minutes contact time for bleach**

✓ Use hand broom and dust pan to clean up spill outside in

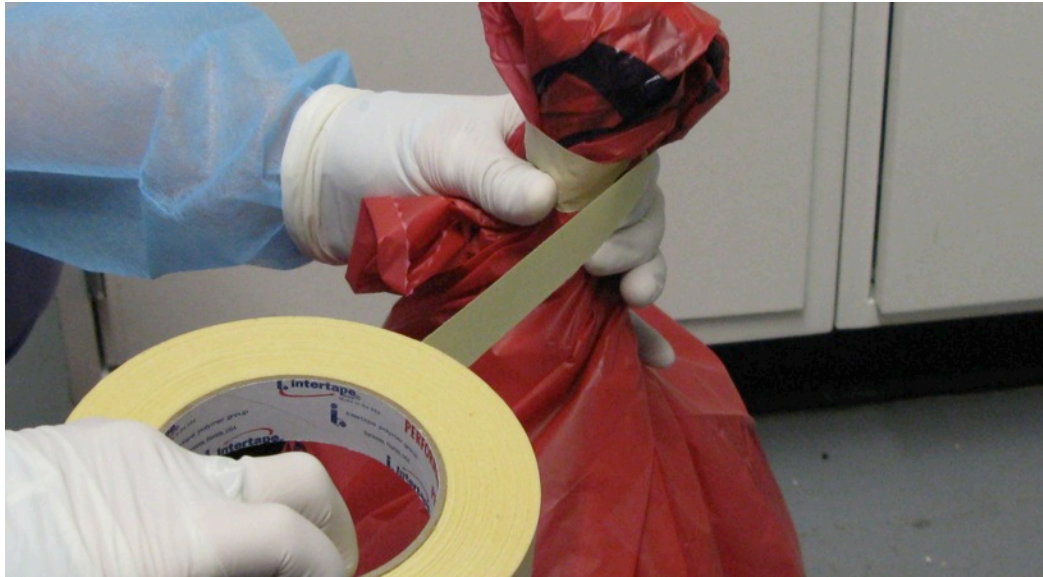


✓ **Dispose in red biohazard bag**
